# 2013 Wilmer C. Fields Awards Competition

Wilmer C. Fields was chief public relations officer for the SBC Executive Committee from 1959-87 and nurtured the growth of the Baptist Public Relations Association, now called Baptist Communicators Association. He lifted the office to national prominence and was a ready spokesman to national media who began to notice the surging Southern Baptist Convention and needed an interpreter. He mentored young communicators and raised their perception of the possibilities for increasing visibility and understanding for their agencies. He encouraged, enabled and led by example, committed to Southern Baptists, to their churches and to the agencies by which they spread the Gospel globally. To honor his foundational role, Baptist communicators named their annual awards competition for W.C. Fields. He is a lifetime member of BCA. The Wilmer C. Fields Awards have been presented since 1964.
